ALABAMA TRAVELER PROGRAM

ASARDA designed this program to encourage our dancers to visit square and round dance clubs throughout the state.

There's a couple ways to find a dance. You can go to the ASARDA website and click on the Calendar tab in the menu on the left and see a list of all upcoming dances. Another way to find a dance is to click on the Clubs menu button and you can find out when each club in the state dances. You can also sort the clubs by District.

OFFICIAL RULES:

1. You must be a current ASARDA member to participate in the program.
2. You may only earn one dangle per year.
3. Cards can be obtained from Anita Southern at the convention or downloaded from the ASARDA website.
4. Couples can use the same card.
5. Cards must be filled out & signed by a Club President, official Representative or Caller at the dance visited. Card must include date of event and signees phone number.
6. When you have earned all of the points and the card is properly filled out, present the card to your ASARDA representative before July 31st, and he or she will make arrangements with Anita Southern for you to receive your dangle at the State Convention in August.
7. Dangles will be presented Saturday night at the State Convention.
8. All dancers who have earned their Alabama Traveler Dangle or Super Alabama Traveler Dangle will be listed in the Convention Program, on the ASARDA Website, and ASARDA Newsletter each year.
9. All dancers who have earned ten (10) dangles will receive a ten (10) year bar.

TO EARN THE ALABAMA TRAVELER DANGLE:

1. You must earn seven (7) points within one (1) year beginning at the Alabama State Convention in August through July 31st of the following year.
2. Two (2) points will be given for attending the Alabama State Convention. If you can't attend the Alabama State Convention to earn the two (2) points you need to visit two (2) other Districts to make up your two (2) points.
3. Only one (1) point can be earned for a club or dance in your district.

4. The remaining four (4) points MUST come from visiting clubs or attending dances in other districts than yours – one (1) point per dance.

TO EARN A SUPER ALABAMA TRAVELER DANGLE:

1. Before earning the Super Alabama Traveler Dangle you must have earned your Alabama Traveler Dangle a previous year.
2. You must earn ten (10) points within one (1) year beginning at the Alabama State Convention in August through July 31st of the following year.
3. Two (2) points will be given for attending the Alabama State Convention. If you can't attend the Alabama State Convention to earn the two (2) points you need to visit two (2) other Districts to make up your two (2) points.
4. Two (2) points can be earned for clubs or dances in your district.
5. Three (3) points MUST be earned from visiting EACH of the other districts (one point per district). You only need to attend at least one (1) dance or visit a club in each district once.
6. The remaining three (3) points must come from attending dances in other states.
